

# RECIPE OF THE MONTH: POCHUTKA (POH-hoot-kah)



How much Turkey do you think you will have this Thanksgiving? If your family is like mine, you will be chomping down on the stuffed bird for several days. How about trying a NEW Slovakian dish this Thanksgiving? What could it hurt?

**Ingredients:**

- 5-6 potatoes
- 1 onion, chopped
- 1 pound of sausage, crumbled
- 1 16-ounce jar/can sauerkraut
- Salt & pepper to taste

**Instructions:**

- Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- Grease a 9 x 13 pan
- Ask mom/dad to peel potatoes and

cut into cubes. Place in large pot to boil (15-20 minutes). Salt optional.

Cook sausage, onion, salt & pepper until sausage is brown.

Drain potatoes, spread in the baking pan. Add sausage and top off with sauerkraut. Bake for 20 minutes. Makes 4-6 servings. ENJOY!
